

## **Addendum Article VI - Officers**

The officers of the club shall be made up of a 10 member board of directors. The top 10 volunteers with the most recorded volunteer hours from the previous calendar year who choose to participate will comprise the board. Participation on the board is entirely voluntary.

Qualifiers to be eligible to be on the Mudcutter Board of Directors:

- 1) The volunteer must be registered with LCPR and/or Collier County parks and be actively recording their own volunteer hours per county requirements for a minimum of 3 years.
- 2) The candidate for board member must be a current Mudcutter member and have a minimum of 3 years of experience working with the club.
- 3) The candidate for board member must honor and abide by the IMBA-SORBA Chapter Officer Code of Conduct at all times.
- 4) Each Board member must sign the IMBA-SORBA Chapter Officer Code of Conduct agreement each year so that it can be filed with SORBA.
- 5) Each candidate for board member must be available to communicate by e-mail and text messaging by the other board members.
- 6) To remain on the board or to be invited to be on the board the following year, each board member must attend at least 60% of the scheduled board meetings.

Terms of the office shall be one year. At the end of each year the potential new members will be identified by their recorded volunteer hours. If a volunteer chooses not to fill their seat on the board, the volunteer with the next highest recorded hours will be invited to participate until the complete 10 member board is identified.

Only current board members may place a vote. An active member who has recorded volunteer hours may attend a board meeting, contribute ideas and assist with planning, but have no voting rights.

Club meetings or member meetings shall be held at a public facility and all current members shall be invited. See Article IX.
